Remember to Vote!

ANCHORAGE -- The State of Alaska Division of Elections website is reporting that over [119,000 Alaskans](#) have participated in the Special Primary Election by either returning their ballot by mail, voting absentee in-person, or voting early at one of the [available locations](#)!

With less than 48 hours to the close of Election Day, Alaskans for Better Elections wants to remind all voters to make sure their voice is heard in the Special Primary Election.

Important Reminders:

- The deadline to request a ballot for [electronic delivery is 5 pm, today, Friday, June 10](#). These ballots must be postmarked or returned by Election Day, June 11.
- [Absentee in-person voting](#) is available from 9am and most locations statewide close by 5 pm today, Friday, June 10.
- [Regional Elections Offices](#) are open today, Friday, June 10 from 8am-5pm, and will also be open tomorrow, Election Day, June 11 for [absentee in-person voting](#) from 7am until 8pm.
- The Division of Elections is providing a ballot tracking service so voters can track the status of their ballot and receive [ballot tracking notifications](#) by text, email, or phone.
- Voters are strongly encouraged to take their ballot to a United States Postal Service Office and ask for the postage to be hand canceled.
- Ballots can be returned to any of the [regional offices](#) until 8 pm on Election Day or any of the [absentee in-person sites](#) that are open until 5 pm on June 10, 2022

For voters who choose to return their ballot by mail

1. Vote for only one candidate on the ballot.
2. Place the ballot in the provided secrecy sleeve.
3. Place the ballot and secrecy sleeve into the return envelope.
4. Sign the voter affidavit on the backside, top-left of the return envelope, under the envelope flap.
5. Have another adult sign and date the witness signature line.
6. Provide an identifier (AK Driver's License No., Date of Birth or Last 4 of SSN).
7. Seal the envelope.
8. Leave the perforated tab in place to protect your signature and identifier, which are both deemed confidential by the State of Alaska.
9. Request hand-canceling from the Post Office to ensure that voters confirm their return requirements.
